
Disclaimer and Other Information

Programs



Additional Info

Check out for departures is at 11 AM on Saturday. We suggest booking the latest flight available on Saturday. If arrival or departure happens a day before or after the start or end of the program, please request an **extra night request form.** (applicable fees for the extra night, meals and guardian).

Closer to arrival, we will provide an electronic presentation with a guideline of what is needed for Vancouver. Campers can contact their parents anytime during their free time using their phones. Parents and Agents can also contact The Camp Team, as the camp line is available 24/7. However, it is advised to avoid making non-emergency calls between 10 PM and 7 AM Vancouver time.

We will teach and help campers to do their laundry as part of our Life Skills program. However, camp fees do not include any laundry costs.

Safety is a priority! We have a minimum of 2 adults for every 10 campers, plus mobile Social Media coordinators, a senior team, campus security, and UBC staff. We are trained and Certified in First Aid &CPR; all have a criminal background check.

We understand that making the right decision for your student's well-being is important to you. Our directors personally connect with you to understand your needs and address any concerns. With **over 20 years of experience**, we value the trust you place in us to care for your students.

After the initial conversation or virtual cafecito, we communicate via WhatsApp and/or email. If you choose to join our program, we ensure ongoing communication leading up to the start of the program and of course, during the program. You'll receive newsletters and occasional videos via WhatsApp, where our Virtual Team Al Members will provide all the necessary information about the trip to Canada. We aim to keep you informed and prepared well in advance.

A non-refundable \$500 registration fee is required to secure your student's place in our camps.

50% is due by March 8th, 2024, and the remaining balance is 60 days before the start of the program (due by June 10th, 2024 latest or a \$200 late payment charge will be applied to your outstanding balance. No payments are accepted after June 21st.

All refunds will be made sixty (60) days after the end of our summer programs and with prior written notification by parents/guardians.
