## Kingswood Royal Holloway Campus

### Descripción del Programa

La sede de este curso de verano es el prestigiado y exclusivo Kingswood Hall campus de la Royal Holloway University of London. Se localiza en Egham, a tan solo 8 kms de Royal Windsor y rodeado de la hermosa campiña inglesa.

El campus es muy grande y ofrece 200 habitaciones individuales nuevas con baño privado y 100 habitaciones renovadas con baño compartido. Todas las habitaciones tienen lavabo, ropero, escritorio silla y cama, que se limpian una vez por semana. Hay disponibilidad de una sala común con cocineta y refrigerador. Además de un cuarto para lavar ropa con máquinas tragamonedas. Una moderna cafetería donde se sirven los alimentos y WiFi en todo el campus.

Un enorme y moderno Centro de Actividades con TV y mesas de juego. Los desayunos completos de sirven 4 días por semana y 3 desayunos tipo Continental. Las comidas y cenas barra de ensaladas, frutas, postre, un pan y 3 platos calientes para escoger. Los días de paseo se ofrece un lunch para llevar. Hay maquinas de refrigerios y tomar el té. El personal del Camp sabe primeros auxilios y hay supervisión 24/7.

Deportes: Futbol y squash. Mini Olimpiada. Actividades vespertinas: Busca del Tesoro, taller de drama, karaoke, show de talentos y juegos por equipos.

Paseos de medio día incluidos: Henley, Royal Windsor y Kew Gardens. Paseos de día completo incluidos: A los mejores museos y galerías de Londres así como otros históricos lugares. Paseos opcionales NO incluidos en el precio: Thorpe Park, Museo de Madame Tussaud y al London Eye.

# Kingswood Royal Holloway

Age range: 10 - 17

Dates: 23 Jun - 11 Aug

Our centre is located on the Kingswood Hall campus of Royal Holloway University of London near the town of Egham, surrounded by beautiful countryside and only 5 miles from Royal Windsor.

The campus has plenty of outdoor space to enjoy and offers a mix of single en-suite and standard rooms, as well as a large activity room for communal use.

## Accommodation

- Single en-suite and standard rooms available with shared bathroom ratio of around 1:5 students
- Washbasins in all standard rooms
- Large activity room with TV and games for student use

- Rooms are cleaned weekly

- Students will be placed in an international class with students of different nationalities

## Campus facilities

---

### Accommodation

The accommodation consist of 200 modern, spacious en-suite rooms with shared kitchen pantry and access to a fridge. We also have 100 newly refurbished standard rooms with wash basin and shared refurbished bathrooms at an approximate ratio of 1:5, all with shared pantry.

### Common areas

Our spacious Activity Club is opened daily until 22.30 with sofas, TV and games for students. There is also benches outside in an enclosed green courtyard for socialising and an IT suite available for students to use.

### Cleaning

- Rooms cleaned weekly
- Common areas cleaned daily
- Shared student bathrooms cleaned daily
- Linen changed weekly

### Laundry

Available onsite with drying facilities.

### Meals

- Breakfast consist of 3x English Breakfast and 4x Continental per week.
- Lunch and Dinner include a choice of 3 hot meals (one vegetarian) with salad bar, fruit, dessert and bread roll.
- Tea and Coffee available with all meals.
- Halal option is available.
- Packed lunches for all full day trips contain sandwich, water, crisps, fruit and cake.

Vending machines offer drinks and snacks. The College run kiosk at reception sells refreshments, toiletries and other essential items.

## Programme information

---

### Arrival

Coaches arrive by the canteen in the Car Park where groups are met by Centre Staff before being registered and checked into their rooms.

### Welcome

On the first evening there will be a welcome activity which is designed to ensure students have the opportunity to meet staff and other students and get to know more about the campus, its facilities and useful information which will help them during their stay.

### Activities

Activities are organised every Monday to Friday and every evening all week, for students not on a prepaid excursion or any additional optional trips. These activities could be on-site or near to the centre. These may include:

- **Sports** such as football, mini Olympics, rounders, table tennis, volleyball and basketball
- **Daytime activities** such as scavenger hunts and drama workshops
- **Evening activities** such as karaoke, talent show and team games

### Half-day trips

Half Day Excursions to local towns and attractions of interest including Henley Upon Thames, Royal Windsor, and the fantastic Kew Gardens.

### Excursions

One midweek Full Day Trip to London to include Westminster and Southbank Walks, London's Best Museums and Galleries and Historic Sights.

**One Full Day Trip every Saturday to Brighton, Oxford or Cambridge.**

### Optional excursions

Additional famous London attractions such as Madame Tussauds and the London Eye are easily accessible by train from Egham station. The campus is situated in close proximity to Thorpe Park.
