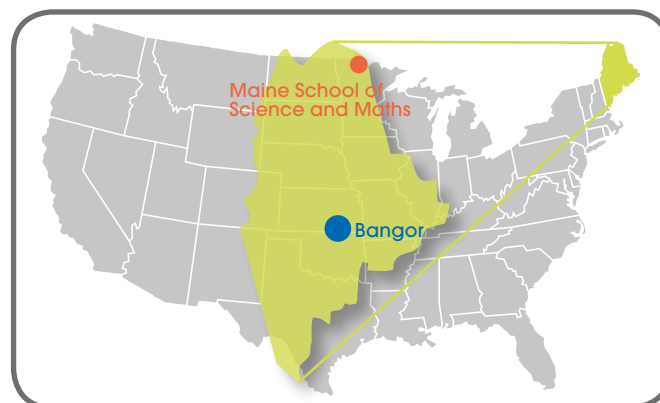
School Profile

The school is ranked by the U.S. News and World Report as one of the Top 100 high schools in the United States out of over 10,000. The school has many clubs for math, robotics and many others. MSSM only recruits among the top 3% of students in from the state. 100 % of their students were accepted to high level 4 year colleges.

MSSM was recognized by U.S. News & World Report as the 14th best math and science high school out of about 600 in the nation.
