

Barton Court Grammar School - Kent, UK

Barton Court is a coeducational Grammar School set around an ancient lake in beautiful walled grounds on the edge of Canterbury. Just over 900 students attend the school, including a Sixth Form of over 200.

The original school house dates back to 1750 but the school has many new and modern facilities including a purpose built food technology classroom, ICT (Information Communication Technology) rooms, and new Modern Foreign Language suites. A new library opened in 2008 and the sports hall opened in May 2009.
