Academics at Richard Huish

In 2012, 99% of our students achieved A* to E grades at A level. 88% of our students achieved three or more A levels at A* - E in facilitating subjects. 10% of our students achieved three A levels at AAB in facilitating subjects.

Facilitating subjects are Maths, English, Sciences, Modern Languages, History and Geography. They are preferred subjects selected by The Russell group of the 20 largest research based universities in the country, to aid student A level choice. In 2012, 18 of our students were offered places to read degrees at Oxford and Cambridge Universities. That placed us 5th out of all "non-selective" state schools that send candidates to Oxford. One in three of our applicants are successful, in contrast to a national average of around one in six.
