Subjects Offered

Junior Cycle (1st - 3rd Year): All students take the following subjects – English, Irish, Maths, Science, French, History, Geography, Art, Music, Physical Education, CSPE, Religion **OPTION** of 1 out of – German, Home Economics, Technical Graphics.

Senior Cycle: (5th & 6th Year): All leaving Cert students take the following – English, Maths, Physical Education, French or German plus **OPTION** of 1 from each line:

- Chemistry or Geography or Art
- Biology or Business Studies
- Physics or History or Economics
- German or Home Economics or Technical Drawing or Music.
