### EN GENERAL ENGLISH

The General English experience is the choice for most international summer students at Trinity. This option provides classroom instruction in speaking, listening, reading and writing, with a focus on helping students of all proficiency levels to improve in their fluency and accuracy of speech.

Monday and Wednesday afternoon lessons offer students the chance to expand their language skills outside the traditional classroom setting. These sessions involve engaging tasks, such as hands-on workshops, teacher-led excursions, and visits to local attractions. Each activity is thoughtfully designed to complement the morning lessons, ensuring a cohesive and logical learning experience that keeps students actively applying their language skills in real-world contexts.
