Descripción del Programa

Cambridge, antigua y famosa ciudad universitaria inglesa, se encuentra a casi 80 km de Londres. Descubre sus impresionantes edificios, el río Cam que corre detrás de sus «colleges». Es una ciudad de tradición histórica, con muchos museos, iglesias antiguas y miles de estudiantes.

La sede del programa es el moderno Abbey College, prestigiado colegio privado con internado, se localiza en una tranquila zona residencial al norte de la ciudad. Las aulas tienen modernos pizarrones interactivos. Hay una sala deportiva bajo techo, una cancha de fútbol y de basquetbol o volibol.

Las actividades incluyen divertidos juegos. Partidos de fútbol, basquetbol y volibol. Noches de talentos, de disco, de películas, kareoke y muchas actividades más. En las salas de descanso hay mesas de juego. WiFi gratuito en todo el campus que está bien comunicado con Cambridge a través de transporte público.

Incluye desayuno, lunch, cena diariamente y se sirven en la moderna cafetería. El menú ofrece una gran selección de alimentos. Entre comidas se vende fruta, refrigerios, bebidas calientes y refrescos.

Alojamiento en el dormitorio del College, en cuarto individual con baño privado con baño compartido.

Los paseos incluidos son a Londres, Oxford y Stratford-Upon-Avon. Además de una visita cultural de medio día por semana en Cambridge para visitar la Catedral Ely, el King's College; hacer "punting" en el Río Cam; y visitar la Round Church.

Los paseos opcionales (con costo adicional) son al parque de diversiones Thorpe; al Castillo de Windsor; a la ciudad de Brighton y a los Estudios Warner Bros, donde se filmaron algunas de las películas de Harry Potter.

Half Day

Ely Cathedral

Ely Cathedral, is an Anglican cathedral in the city of Ely, Cambridgeshire, England. The cathedral has its origins in AD 672 when St Etheldreda built an abbey church. The present building dates back to 1083, and it was granted cathedral status in 1109.

King's College

King's College Chapel is the chapel

of King's College in the University of Cambridge. It is considered one of the finest examples of late Perpendicular Gothic English architecture and features the world's largest fan vault.

Punting on the River Cam

Relax on a Punt Tour of the river and take in the beautiful views of the college "Backs" – the ideal opportunity to take photographs of the iconic colleges, from a unique and privileged viewpoint.

Cambridge Round Church

A rare 12th-century gem, gracefully stands at the heart of historic Cambridge. Its unique circular design and ancient walls whisper tales of centuries gone by. Whether you seek architectural marvels or a moment of reflection, this enchanting church offers a timeless sanctuary where history and spirituality converge.

Windsor and Windsor Castle

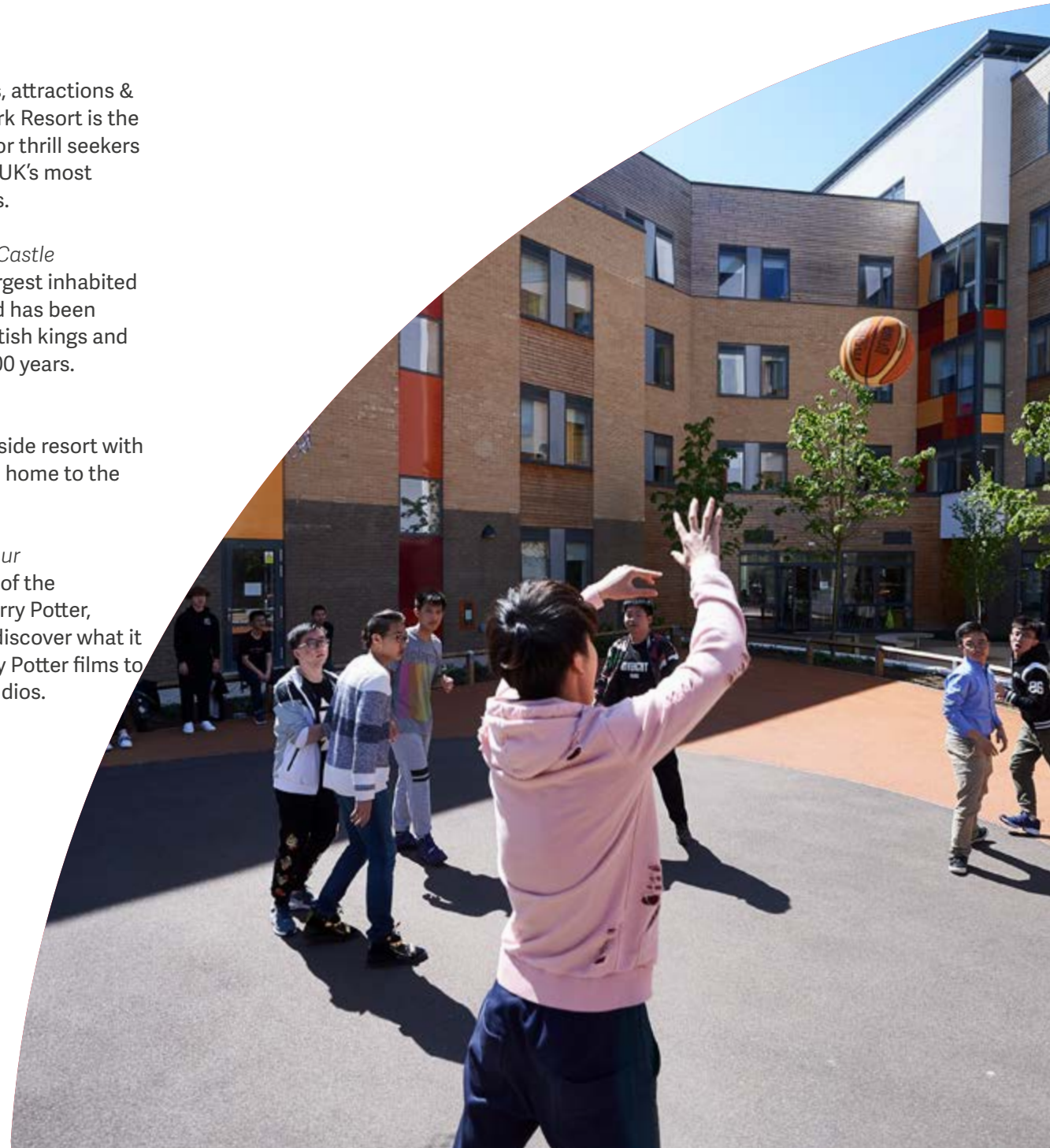
Visit the oldest and largest inhabited castle in the world and has been the family home of British kings and queens for almost 1,000 years.
